## Message from the principal

Dear families,

With our first few small groups of quarantines over the past few weeks, I just want to take a few minutes to address what we continue to do here at LHS to keep your students safe.

- Students and staff are required to wear masks in the building at all times (and students have truly been amazing!).
- Classes are small so that students can maintain a 6 foot distance whenever possible.
- Classroom desks are cleaned between every class by teachers.
- Tables in the atrium are cleaned between every class by custodians, counselors, and the admin team.
- Every bathroom has an additional soap dispenser so that we don't run out of soap.
- The district has adjusted the proportion of fresh air in the building, and I must say that the air movement feels noticeable.
- We encourage socially distancing at all times and though adolescents are not perfect, they do a pretty decent job of honoring that request.
- The district can assist schools with a deep clean if needed, as addressed in my letter from last Sunday night.

It feels like LHS is doing our best to help keep school clean and sanitary for in person learning each day. My next "ask" is a bit of an overreach, but please encourage your student to also do their best to adhere to similar guidelines when outside of school whether at work, socializing with friends, carpooling, or other situations. I know many of these practices are not how we wish to live each day, me included. Yet with cold and flu season nearly upon us, I want to be able to have the ability to continue school in person and the more students adhere to health guidelines, the better chance we have to continue with school as designed this year. The district sent updated quarantine processes and protocols last evening, please be sure to check your email for this information.

Again, I know this is a large request, but I deeply care about providing the best education possible to students both in-person and remotely and we need our students help to make this happen. Thank you for your consideration and support.
